Lentswe, Jouberton - Leano la Bophelo Project is a community-based organization from Jouberton in Extension 24.

They are pleading with private companies to consider them through the utilization

of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs.

In celebrating heritage month on Monday September 18, staff was sharing traditional meals with job seekers around Klerksdorp and sharing much needed in-

formation regarding Matlosana heritage and how to engage in heritage activities which will create employment for them. This is a build-up activity to which the organization has other activities underway to be celebrated in schools. Activities include story-telling, traditional music and dance, indigenous games, traditional food and indigenous language uses and different customs.

They have planned a series of roadshows to townships in the area to mobilize young artists and crafts men and women to be part of the main event to be celebrated on Friday September 29 at Goudkoppie Heritage Hill.

They invite members of the community to be part of the celebration. Everyone is invited to occupy a stall to market and sell their products and services on the day of the event. Leano la Bophelo will be cooking and serving traditional cuisine to everyone attending the event. There will be performance of traditional groups and enjoyment of traditional music.

The organisation was established in 2010 by a group young people who identified a need for an organisation that will create work and provide training to young people around the communities

of Matlosana and the district. Its other objective is to restore and maintain heritage sites across the district at the same time promoting and embracing the peoples of Matlosana historical heritage.

Since establishment of Leano la Bophelo, the organisation has empowered over 800 young people through skills on beautification, horticulture and provided short term employment through its EPWP projects to work on site practically.

Leano la Bophelo has been providing cleaning services since 2018 supported by Independent Development Trust and parks,

walkways, N12 rockery, clinics and public spaces have been cleaned and maintained. The organisation has extended its activities to schools in communities around Matlosana which includes Jouberton, Kanana and Tigane. In total the workers are assisting in eight schools. Our workers are also assisting public schools to start food gardens which continues to assist underprivileged and food insecure households with vegetables.

Midvaal Water Company is a Non-profit Company that supplies bulk, clean water to its Customers.

Since 69 years ago, Midvaal Water has grown to become a reliable and dependable Water Services Provider (WSP) that supplies bulk water to the City of Matlosana and the mines in the area. It also supplies some communities in the Moqhaka Local Municipality in the Free State.

Through its state-of-the-art infrastructure, the Company supplies about 130 megalitres (Ml) per day of clean water. At full capacity, Midvaal Water Company can supply 320 megalitres of clean water per day. Therefore, the Company has a spare capacity of almost 200 megalitres per day. This spare capacity puts Midvaal Water in a good position to contribute in ongoing efforts to resolve the water challenges in and across our province (North West).

As a result, Midvaal Water is embarking on an expansion programme to broaden access to clean water in areas in the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District, specifically JB Marks and Maquassi Hills, and those facing water challenges in the Ngaka Modiri Molema and Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati districts, respectively.

For these noble plans to succeed, there is a need for Midvaal Water's Customers including the City of Matlosana to pay for services rendered by Midvaal Water Company. Since the Company is not-for-profit and does not have shareholders, the surplus made through providing its services, gets reinvested in growing and improving its operations and maintaining and refurbishing its infrastructure.
